Allhallows Place Touring Park Terms and Conditions

- We hope that you find your stay at Allhallows Place enjoyable and relaxing. In order to achieve this and for the well-being and safety of all our guests, we have a few guidelines we ask you to follow:-
- Only prior booking permits entry onto site.
- Dogs are occasionally permitted but must be neutered, of good temperament and remain the full responsibility of their owners at all times. Dogs should only be allowed to foul in the dog walk area provided. Please clean up after you.
- When driving on the park we ask you to adhere to the 5mph speed limit and one-way system. We can only allow on vehicles declared at the time of booking. The park is closed to all vehicular traffic between 22:30 hrs and 07:00 when the gate will be locked. Commercial vans are strictly forbidden to enter the site.
- We have gone to great lengths to provide luxury shower facilities for your use. Please ensure that they are left clean and tidy after you have used them. Children under 12 must be accompanied by an adult when using the facilities.
- The hedgerow that surrounds the park is protected and is a wildlife habitat. We therefore ask you not to enter it or deposit any items in it.
- The trees are not to be climbed or shaken and fruit must not be removed by guests. Likewise flowers are not to be picked.
- The grounds that surround the house are private and entry is by discretion of the camp owners. Guests or visitors are not permitted entry into the main house.
- Please empty rubbish, chemical toilet and wastewater **ONLY** in the areas provided. Do not litter the site in any regard.
- Please do not clean dishes at the water points.
- When washing clothes, please use the Laundry Room and do not hang washing outside caravans or tents. Please use the rotary clothes line provided.
- When using ground sheets, please lift them every other day.
- If using musical instruments, TV's radios, etc, please be aware of other guests and we generally ask you to keep all noise levels to a minimum.
- No ball games are to be played between caravans or tents. Children must be supervised at all times when using the climbing and children's care apparatus.
- When barbecuing, please do not scorch the grass and apply care and attention at all times regarding safety and fire hazards. No barbeque is to be left unattended and camp/open fires are strictly forbidden.
- Visitors of guests will be permitted only at the discretion of the camp owners and by prior arrangement.
- On the day of departure, pitches should be vacated by 12 NOON.
- Under the terms and conditions of our license to operate the maximum continuous stay permitted is 28 days. Repeat visits are permitted to a maximum total stay of 120 days per year running from 1 January.
- We reserve the right of admission at all times, and the right to terminate the stay of any person if this is considered to be in the best interest of other visitors to the park.
- Allhallows Place Touring Park is not responsible for any accident, injury, loss or damage to persons or property while using any part of the park howsoever caused.
- Guest mail must not be forwarded to the camp, nor can guests/visitors use our address as their own.
